New Features, Improvements, and Known Issues

Abstract

The release notes for ExtremeCloud™ SD-WAN version 25.1.0 detail new features, improvements, and known issues. Key technical points include the addition of QoS Profile support in Common Objects, allowing users to create, modify, and delete multiple QoS Profiles in one place. Addressed issues include support for multiple email addresses in notification rules, improved scrollbar visibility, and correct report mapping in the Application report. Known issues involve synchronization failures with the Network Time Protocol (NTP) server in the FE LAN. The document provides comprehensive information on the latest software release, including troubleshooting tips and important configurations for successful deployment.

XCW-7797	QoS Profile Support in Common Objects	The Common Objects tab now includes QoS Profiles. You can create, modify, and delete multiple QoS Profiles in one place.

Addressed Issues in SD-WAN 25.1.0

Issue ID	Description
CFD-13344	Previously, adding multiple email addresses in notification rules was not supported. Now, you can enter multiple addresses in the notification rules.
CFD-13301	The scrollbar now remains visible even when zooming out or using a high screen resolution.
CFD-13243	An issue in report generation caused the Application report to display the Application group and vice versa, leading to incorrect report mapping.
CFD-13206	Dashboard connection detail lines extend beyond the node location when the connection is down, causing misalignment.
CFD-13096	When filtering the alarms, the Download option does not match the displayed results.
CFD-13095	The message No results found appears at the top of the alarms, even when the alarms are present.
CFD-13094	Several alarms are triggered for a single unplugged interface, leading to excessive notifications.
CFD-13092	You can now deploy the configuration successfully after onboarding a new site.
CFD-13004	In Fabric SD-WAN, an error message appears if the appliance is not managed by XIQ-SE.
CFD-12875	Tunnel failure alarms are raised and cleared on a disconnected interface.
CFD-12530	No-default-gateway alarms appear for a short duration.
CFD-12352	Disconnected From Orchestrator alarms are repeatedly triggered.

Issue ID	Description
WAF-927	The appliance fails to synchronize with the Network Time Protocol (NTP) server in the FE LAN.
