Problems Resolved

When connecting a BayStack 5510 SX or LX GBIC to an OPTera Metro 5200 OCI card, the link would not come up (Q00938336).

Radius authentication was disabled in SSH versions of 4.0.0 and 4.0.1 (Q00958850-01).

In previous code versions, static ARP entries were deleted after the corresponding MAC addresses aged out (Q00953766).

A problem with static route entries (created by JDM) not saved after reboot is addressed in this release (Q00927913).

8. Known Issues

If ports are administratively disabled/enabled or if links are disconnected/reconnected, static ARP entries get erased (Q00985108). This issue will be resolved in the upcoming 4.1 release.
