The following are know issues for the BayStack 420 10/100/1000 Switch, Software Version 1.1.0:

- When using MAC Address Security, if a unit is reset, then the MAC addresses that were allowed access will no longer be allowed access. To resolve this issue, disable and reenable the MAC Address Security. (CR Q00511575)
- If you re-enable an active port that is in blocking mode, then the spanning tree application may fail to operate on that port. Avoid enabling any ports that have already been enabled. If you should encounter this issue, disable and reenable the effected ports. (CR Q00510539)
