WebUI: Disabling the WebUI (also called the virtual access console) no longer affects captive web portal functionality

New Features and Enhancements

This release introduces the following new features and enhancements:

Client 360 View Improvements: In support of the improvements made in HiveManager, HiveOS 8.4r3 features more robust timing information, so that administrators can track and troubleshoot client connections to network services and devices.

Multicast-to-Unicast Conversion: Multicast frames that contain VLAN information are now converted to unicast frames and delivered to stations on the appropriate SSIDs and VLANs.
