| WI01182555           | Router and VPN client were able to connect in "vpn-only" mode even when interfaces are registered to security. |
| SR2K4K-80            | System memory constantly declining due to memory leak.   |
| SR2K4K-81            | SR2330 running out of memory due to memory leak.   |
| SR2K4K-86            | Memory leak during IKES Session while on console.  |
| SR2K4K-89            | Router stops accepting SSH and telnet connections over period of time.   |
| SR2K4K-92            | Hex data was being dumped to the console, when performing continuous SSH connections to the router.            |
| SR2K4K-96            | SSH and Telnet sessions not released after executing CLI command.  |
