

Release notes for Contivity VPN Client ver. 3.0:

- New feature allows users to connect to a Contivity Switch by DNS name or IP address.
- Support for SUSE Linux version 8.2 has been added.
- Support for Solaris version 2.9 has been added.
- Configurations can now be locked to prevent editing and deletion, and optionally creation of new configurations can be disallowed.
- New feature for pre-configured client distribution can be used to force entry of licensed seat number by the end user.
- The Client now supports import and use of digital certificates.
- Support for MacOSX version 10.3 (Panther) has been added.
- Support for switch failover (when enabled at the Contivity Switch) has been added to the client.
- Various GUI and documentation changes were made pursuant to Apani Networks acquisition of Netlock product lines.
- Added support for Linux RedHat version 9.0.
- Installer file names for Linux distributions have been modified for clarity.
- Improvements were made to Client shutdown processing.
