Q02017311 –

The Nortel VPN Router disable new logins option may prevent the VPN Client failover feature from functioning.

Q02038863 –

The Nortel VPN Client may not clear the authentication Passcode field on the screen after a Client disconnect. This only occurs if the Respond Only Token with Two Factor authentication is configured.

If the DNS address from the destination field is changed the configuration must be saved before trying to connect. Unless the configuration is saved, VPN client may try to connect with the old DNS value.
