Q01308927 –

When upgrading to the 6.01.100 Client the Group password is not saved properly. This requires the user to re-enter the group password in order to connect successfully

Q01377196 –

The Nortel VPN Client Isakmp KeepAlive mechanism may behave inconsistently when NAT Traversal is used on the tunnel.

Q01722357 –

The Nortel VPN Client may attempt to connect to the incorrect IP address if the primary Server in a load balancing environment fails to respond.

Q01738191 –

While tabbing through the Nortel VPN client GUI page the Passcode field may be bypassed going from the User Name field to the Destination field.

Q01753829 –

If a network bridge is created with multiple adapters in a pc running Windows XP, the Nortel VPN Client filter driver binding will fail.
