Problems Resolved in This Release

Nortel Networks VPN Router sustaining release Version 8.05.400 resolves the following issues:

wi00527943 -

If the text entered in the authentication banner on the Nortel VPN Router with a preceding empty line, the empty line may be removed.

wi00700997 -

On VPN router, admin banner file (banner.txt) may not get transferred to system folder of new version after upgrade.

wi00817076 -

Nortel VPN Client connections configured for Client Address Redistribution may not timeout properly when disconnected.

wi00825572 -

The VPN Router Client banner will contain the text "none" when display banner is enabled and the default banner is set to None.

wi00825931 -

The Nortel VPN Router may crash when its management IP is configured as a HTTP proxy in a web browser.

wi00827730 -

The Nortel VPN Router may core when an external DHCP server is configured as the source of the User Tunnel IP address.

wi00835228 -

The Nortel VPN Router may core when configured for the IP Tunnel MIB SNMP query.

wi00837026 -

The "tracert" command will fail from a local network endpoint to the remote network endpoint via a branch office tunnel.

9. Known Limitations

When QOS Classifiers are configured on GUI page (QOS->Classifiers) or using CLI Commands "qos mf-class XXX":

- 1. A classifier or rule name containing the "?" character cannot be configured using the CLI; it must be configured from the GUI.
- 2. The backslash cannot be used as part of a classifier or rule name.
- 3. If you create a rule or classifier name, the "show running config" command will display the rule or name within double quotes.
