To receive events from Zebra Wireless Insights API, the device needs to have a valid *Zebra Edge Insight standard perpetual license* installed, as well as staged to enable Zebra Wireless Insights API. Contact your Zebra sales representative to order a license. You also need to link the **Extreme Licensing** portal using the **License Manager** application, as well as assign the correct **Role/Application** to the user with the **User Manager** application. New Features

This release introduces the following features:

Table 1: New Features

ID	Description
EII-381	Some devices became offline while not in use. Zebra devices entered a doze mode when not in use. With this fix, the device enters a battery-saving sleep mode, but it wakes up to send data to the cloud.
EII-706	Location must be synced from ExtremeCloud IQ. Extreme Intuitive Insights v3.5 offers synchronization for all locations from ExtremeCloud IQ to Extreme Intuitive Insights. Synchronization is one way only – from ExtremeCloud IQ to Extreme Intuitive Insights. It is still possible to create a location in Extreme Intuitive Insights, but that location will not appear in ExtremeCloud IQ.

ID	Description
CFD-10788	Addressed an issue where the API swagger was not available on production Regional Data Centers (RDC). The API is available on all production RDCs now.

Known Issues

ID	Description
EII-361	WLAN638/669 code must be processed. Beginning with some Zebra software releases of Android 10 and Android 11 (August 2023 and later), the active analysis data is split between two different WLAN codes. Therefore, Extreme Intuitive Insights is not able to correctly decode and represent the results of the Active Voice Analysis.
